Benjamin Chinitz, a Harvard University economist predicted in the nineteen fifties that containerization will benefit New York by allowing it to ship its industrial products more cost effectively to the Southern USA than other areas can. He did not anticipate that containerization will even make it more cost effective to import such goods from abroad.

Most economic studies of containerization assumed that shipping organizations will begin to replace older kinds of transportation with containerization. The studies did not predict that the process of containerization itself would cause a more direct effect on various producers, along with increasing the overall volume of trade across the globe.

Containerization provides one crucial advantage which is improved cargo security. The cargo is less possible to be stolen because all the products is not visible to the casual viewer. Normally, the doors of the containers are sealed and this means that whatever signs of tampering are more evident. There are a lot of containers which are outfitted along with high-tech electronic monitoring devices. These could be distantly monitored to detect changes in air pressure. This detection occurs when the doors are opened. These monitoring devices have lessened the "falling off the truck" syndrome that long plagued the shipping industry.

There used to be some difficulty with incompatible rail gauge sizes in various nations. Use of the same basic sizes of containers worldwide has lessened the issues that used to normally occur. These days, the majority of rail networks across the globe operate on a 1435 mm gauge track. This is thought to be the standard gauge, although, several nations make use of wider gauges. Several countries in South America and Africa make use of narrower gauges on their networks. All of these countries rely on container trains which makes trans-shipment between various gauge trains much easier.
