Cascade Clamps - Cascade Manufacturing Company was founded in Portland, Oregon in 1943. They started out as a small machine shop at first hiring four individuals. Product sales for their first year of operation amounted to about 60 thousand dollars. The very first recorded sales revenues involved the assembly and machining of stainless-steel valves, pipe fittings and different components. During five years of operation, the business had stretched to forty employees and their annual sales volume had risen to 330 thousand dollars. Now, Cascade is among the top international makers in the material handling business.

Design and manufacturing of the company's initial hydraulic cylinder allowed this young company to aggressively pursue new business opportunities. Throughout the final 60 years, the industry of material handling has developed into a really complex field with Cascade proudly playing a part in its progress. Cascade at the moment continues to develop as the premier supplier of lift truck attachments and numerous associated items. The business feels certain in their ability so as to continue to lead the way within the business by understanding customer's needs in the future and remaining aggressive within the world market.

All through the 1950's, Cascade began to manufacture, design, and promote its hydraulic accessories. A new facility was constructed in the year 1956, to be able to accommodate all the plant offices and operations in Portland, Oregon, which is still the company's present headquarters. Following fifteen years of business, total employees reached one hundred eighty employees and sales had reached nearly 2.3 million dollars.

The next production plant was built in the year 1959 in Springfield, Ohio. 1960 marked Cascade's preliminary transfer into the international world of the material handling industry as the business established interest in Australia, the Netherlands and England.

The business changed its name to Cascade Corporation in the year 1964. In the year 1965, Cascade went public with an initial offering of 200,000 shares of common stock. The business has expanded its manufacturing plants throughout the United States with areas in Warner Robins, Georgia, Portland, Oregon and Springfield, Ohio. Cascade merchandise are fabricated worldwide thanks to many subsidiary operations. In the year 1944, a brand new plant was completed in Almere, the Netherlands which is Cascade's European headquarters. This plant is made to be the ultimate customer service centre.

Continuing to develop, Cascade expanded their product offering further in the year 1996 and 1997 with the dramatic acquisition of 5 companies, together with the international leader in blades, the Kenhar Corporation.
