Platforms that slip onto lift truck forks are easy to install and lock into place. Slip-on style lift attachments have become more popular in view of the fact that they are easy and quick to operate. They provide an economical answer for companies that do not require them on a regular basis. These platforms have a railing system in place, tie offs and skid proof decking accessible. They still require the use of safety machinery by workers but come with these specific features to be able to further the safety of individuals who will be using them. Slip-on work platforms are an ideal alternative for such projects that take place in difficult places or over top of an object.

This type of table lift could be attached with a pin after sliding the platform onto the forks. The industrial lift stand provides extra protection with three rails and a safety screen covering the rear. For added safety, it is a better idea to consider choosing a kind that opens through the front railing instead of the side gate model.

Stock pickers can mount onto a lift truck using the same mechanisms as other platforms but are a lot different. Stock pickers often have a much smaller support surrounding by a front guard partition and railings on three sides. This unit differs from the various platforms in view of the fact that the cage and the surface do not take up the entire fork surface area.

Combination platforms prove really useful whenever employees need a large amount of supplies to be able to accomplish a project planned at a tall height. This style of platform has a larger base section and a security screen around a smaller section. This design is important so that employees can complete their job and not have to worry themselves about any materials sliding onto them if the one operating it tilts or tips the items.

There are lots of accessories available that can attach to your platform that will improve its efficiency much more. For bigger supply stuff like piping, tall racks can be outfitted with guardrails. These racks keep supplies like pipes, brooms and various things from falling off of the platform and hitting other staff. For extra performance, there are toolboxes, trays and tools designed to fasten directly onto the side of the guardrails.
